**PLEASE WAIVE ALL SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS ON OVERNIGHT  
DELIVERIES**

This trial is open to all Schipperkes over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may effect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration & Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not at ringside when required.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle or quick snap collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke, pinch, electric, or dummy collars are prohibited.

All dogs must be on leash and in control at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), child(ren), & guest(s). Any exhibitor whose dog(s), child(ren), or guest(s) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Trial Committee of this trial-giving club on these days will be strictly enforced.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the hotel/motel and show grounds. Hotels/motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to designated hotels/motels or event site can result in disciplinary action by the Show or Trial committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners, exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the trial grounds. You are responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial giving club and it's Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

## **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**Members of the Schipperke Club of America, Crowne Plaza, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to child(ren).**

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

SCA may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against SCA or any official thereof.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules & Regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

**Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by Wednesday, March 17, 2010, 6 P.M. (MT) or when 150 entries for Standard, Jumpers With Weaves Classes & Fifteen and Send Time per day have been reached.** Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Post dated checks and returned checks will invalidate an entry with a \$25 Service Fee charged for returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. There will be no refund for bitches in season and they are not allowed at the Trial. Telephoned & unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by phone are not acceptable. Long distance calls for information on this Trial will be returned **COLLECT**. Calls may be accepted from 9AM to 9PM (MST) ONLY. There is no refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/> This trial will be conducted in accordance with the Regulations for Agility Trials, effective Sept. 1, 2006.

### TRIAL TIMES

Trial will start two hours after Central Rockies Schipperke Club Specialty Best in Show judging ends.

Show hours are 7:00 AM to 9:00 PM

### COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

The rings and crating area are indoors. The course surface is carpet.

There will be one ring.

The course size is approximately 76' x 106' feet.

### COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing.

As per AKC regulations, there will be **NO** Novice familiarization.

A warm-up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump shall be provided.

### MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **no later than Monday, March 29, 2010, 6:00 p.m. MT**. Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. **Move-ups may be sent in writing or e-mailed to the Trial Secretary.** The e-mail move-up will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary. A form is enclosed for your convenience.

### JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

"Starting Jan.1, 2001, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing." Please have your Jump Height card with you at the trial. Measuring of dogs without cards must take place prior to their first class.

### HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. In traditional agility, dogs may, at the handler's option, be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In Preferred dogs must run in the division appropriate to their height. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

### CLASS INFORMATION

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated

### **NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

#### *How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?*

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a Temporary Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a Permanent Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

#### *What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?*

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of

completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

#### *May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?*

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

#### *What is the jump height card challenge process?*

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge Measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request.

Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

### **OBSTACLES**

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition (Sept. 1, 2006) of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

### **FOOD**

There is a food concession available on site with a variety of foods including breakfast, lunch and refreshments.

### PARKING REGULATIONS

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules & regulations of civil authorities and building & parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

\*High in Trial Agility Award is given to the Schipperke that has the highest qualifying score of all dogs competing in the regular agility classes as defined by AKC Agility rules and regulations. The SCA rule states, when two Schipperkes competing in the trial have the same score, regardless of the class or division in which it was earned, the winner of the High In Trial Award shall be the Schipperke running under the SCT with the greatest difference between its running time and the Standard Course Time (SCT minus running time). If the two Schipperkes remain tied, the tie shall stand.

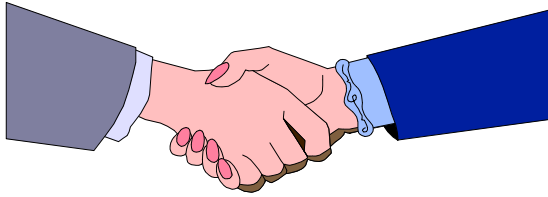
#### **Denver International Airport**

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.
